Definition: Protection of systems, networks, and data from unauthorized access, attacks, or damage.

Why it matters:

- Prevents data breaches & financial loss
- Protects critical infrastructure & public safety
- Builds trust with customers & partners

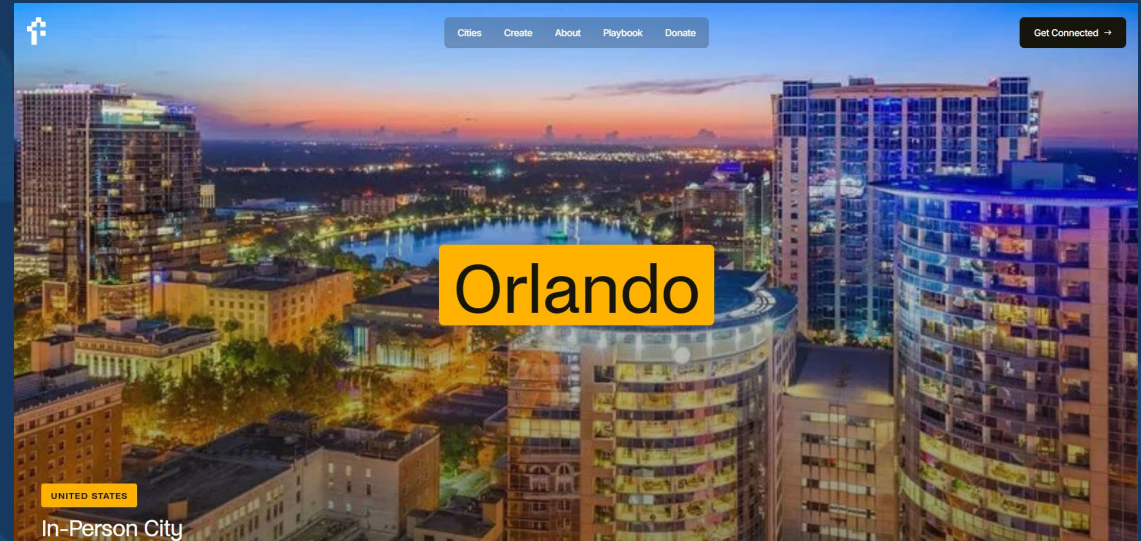

CYBERSECURITY CHECKLIST

☐ **Secure Access to Digital Systems**

- Limit admin access for livestreaming, donation platforms, and websites
- Require multi-factor authentication (MFA) for all staff (email & finance systems)

☐ **Protect Congregant & Donor Data**

- Encrypt all sensitive information
- Use trusted payment processors & avoid storing credit card info locally

☐ **Strengthen Livestream and Media Security**

- Restrict who can post or stream on behalf of the ministry
- Regularly update software

☐ **Maintain Secure Networks**

- Separate guest Wi-Fi from Administrative
- Keep firewalls, routers, and antivirus tools up to date

☐ **Backup and Recovery Plan**

- Follow the 3-2-1 Rule
- Test backups

☐ **Integrate Cyber into Emergency Planning**

☐ **Train and empower the Congregation**

- Phishing Awareness and safe online giving
- Encourage reporting suspicious activity

☐ **Safeguard Physical Systems Connected to Networks**

☐ **Conduct Regular Vulnerability Assessments**

- Use CISA's Houses of Worship Security Self-Assessment Tool
- Review Findings annually and update security policies

☐ **Build Partnerships for Support**

Cybersecurity & Infrastructure Security Agency (CISA)

Resource	Description / Use Case
Houses of Worship Security Self-Assessment Tool	A guided self-assessment web-based tool to help a faith community identify vulnerabilities in their physical and cybersecurity posture, and start prioritizing mitigations.
Paper-based Houses of Worship Security Self-Assessment & User Guide	A printable/version of the self-assessment, for groups that prefer offline or collaborative review. Helps leadership walk through what they currently have and where they need to improve.
“Protecting Places of Worship: Six Steps to Enhance Security Against Targeted Violence” Fact Sheet	A concise guidance piece summarizing six practical high-level steps for faith communities (e.g., understand risk, develop & practice a plan). Good for leadership briefings.
Physical Security Performance Goals for Faith-Based Communities	A resource detailing cost-effective, implementable goals and best practices for faith communities to enhance physical security and resilience.
Translated Resources for Faith-Based/Houses of Worship	Versions of key resources in multiple languages, which is especially helpful if your congregation/membership is multilingual.
Faith-Based Community Audience Page (Cyber & Physical Security)	CISA’s landing page for faith-based communities: provides overview of both physical and cybersecurity resources, plus mission alignment for houses of worship.
“Resources” Library under Protecting Houses of Worship	A collection (guides, infographics, exercise packages, training modules) designed to act as building blocks for improving both physical & cyber security for houses of worship.
